General Expectations

- No drugs or alcohol (intoxication)
- No children
- Any Minors between under 18 years of age will require accompaniment and a minor consent form signed by a parent/guardian
- Designs will not be shared until the Design fee has been received.
- All designs are carefully and thoughtfully designed for you and will not be replicated and will remain property of CatSassTattoo
- You are only booked once a deposit is received and a confirmation has been sent.
- Booking deposits are non refundable and will be applied to your total amount due at end of session
- You are considered a "no show" if you are over 15 minutes late with no communication *see below for more details
- Please be sure you are well hydrated and fed before your session(s)
- Artist refuses to shave anyone so please be sure your desired tattoo area has been freshly shaven the morning of your booking date *visible and fine hairs
- A courtesy reminder will be sent out a couple days before your booked appointment but please remember your booking time(s) and date(s) are your responsibility
- Liability waiver and consent form must be read and signed before application starts and will be provided at the start of your session - a copy will be provided upon request

Free Consultations:

Consultations are an important first step towards developing our collaborative time together. We meet In person whenever possible. This creates an opportunity for artist and client to meet each other and get a better sense of all the expectations and processes to move forward. During consultations, we will discuss where you are wanting your tattoo, what type of elements you are wanting within your design (bring/send reference pictures), what style (black and grey, color, line... etc), size and application, availability and any other thing you may need to move forward. The artist might also make suggestions to better fit your body, spot and/or time frame in order to create a meaningful piece of artwork that you will treasure for a lifetime. Your design fee

Design Fee:

The design fee is non-refundable. It goes towards whatever time it takes me to design your forever tattoo previously discussed during our consult. Every design is created specifically for each client and will not be replicated once permanently applied. Please keep in mind that you are being charged for a service and all artwork remains the property of Amy Louise of Cat Sass Tattoo. Designing will not start until design fee has been received so you can take whatever time you may need to think it over and/or change your mind.

Design fees are currently on a \$50-\$100 sliding scale based on the research, time and detail necessary to establish your design. This will be determined during the consult. If you are comfortable with proceeding after your free consult, please send discussed design fee amount to catsasstattoo@gmail.com to start the process. Designing does not start until this design fee has been received.

The first drawing sent will be focussing mostly on composition and will evolve towards your ideal finished design. Please take all the time you need looking at the details to be sure you love it. Once your forever design has been established, it is time to book your application date. If the original design discussed needs to be changed at clients request to include extra details, elements and/or changes, an additional design fee may be required.

Booking and Application Fee Details:

A non-refundable \$50 booking deposit is required to secure your booking date and time. This goes towards your first hour as well as covers artists loss of reservation time and preparations of last minute cancel or no-show. You are considered a "no show" if you are 15 minutes passed

your booking start time without communication. To rebook after a last minute cancel or no show will require a \$100 booking deposit.

Original Art Work:

Every design is created specifically for each client and will not be replicated once permanently applied. Please keep in mind that you are being charged for a service and all artwork remains the property of Amy Louise of Cat Sass Tattoo.

Sanitation and Sterilization Procedures

All surfaces and equipment elements are thoroughly washed with green soap and kept clean, before, during and after all sessions. Medicom Dry-Back 2 Ply waterproof Bibs are used as a spill barrier and disposed of immediately after session.

As the tattoo space is a private, in-home, personal space dedicated solely to tattooing, easy and careful monitoring of the space is ensured to maintain high levels of sanitation.

All cartridge needles are one time use only and are only opened directly before use and safely discarded immediately after each session. Inks and distilled water are also one time use only and any remainder after sessions are immediately discarded.

Medical grade masks and non-latex gloves are also used and discarded after each use whenever necessary.

Please be sure to shave your tattoo area the day of your tattoo session. Skin is carefully prepped using a cream based sanitizer and fresh tattoos are cleaned using a solution of distilled water and witch hazel.

Medical grade clear and breathable film bandage wrap is used to lock in skins natural healing fluids and enzymes promoting safe and clean healing during the first 3 days after application.

Artist annually takes and adheres to the safety protocols and information of the Blood Borne Pathogen course available online through NIC.

The safety and integrity of everyone involved is of greatest importance! Every tattoo comes with a small container of in house made Salve. All ingredients are harvested, collected and sourced locally.
